## Assembly

- ◆ Laminate and trim.
- ◆ Play in small group (teacher directed).
- ◆ Have an answer key available for challenges (attached).

(Glue in a folder and laminate.)

## To Play

- ◆ Score sheet

### To play

- ◆ Player/team chooses category and point value.
- ◆ Teacher turns the answer card over and reads the definition
- ◆ Student/team then provides the answer in question format. If correct, teacher turns over the picture card.

Ex: Student: "I'll take people for 400."

Teacher: "someone who uses a parachute."

Student: What is skydiver?
