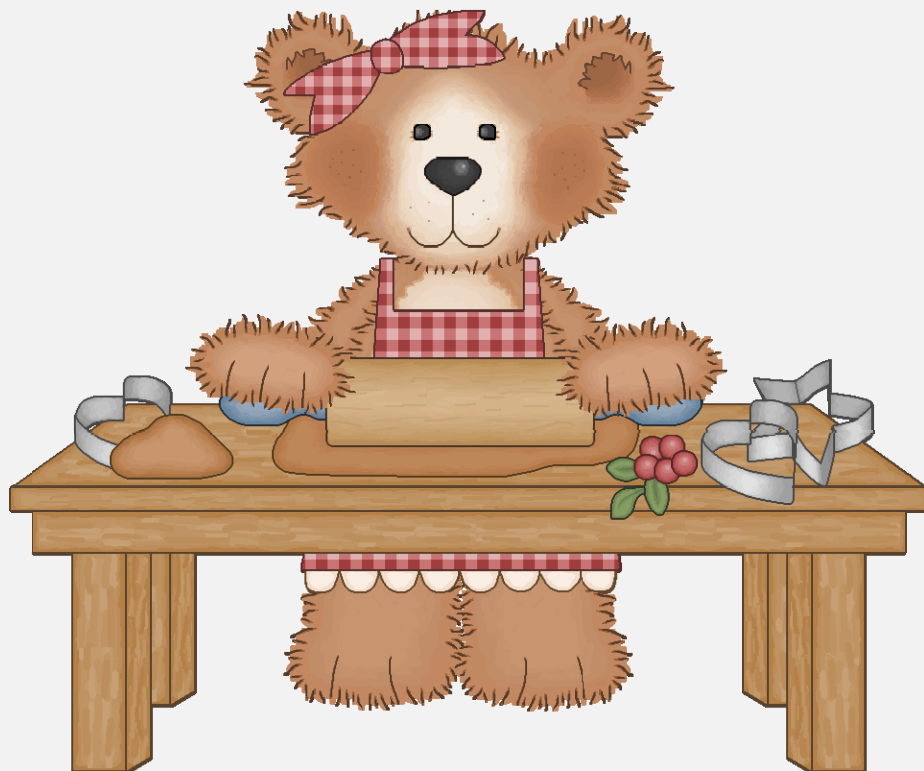

With your meatballs rolling all over the place

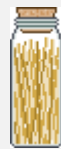
And sauce smeared over your face?!

Do they eat the cookie dough?

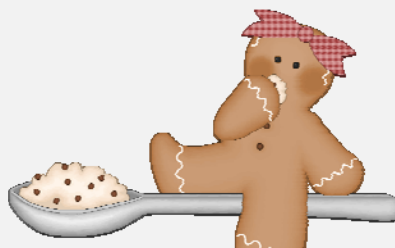
Do they like to stitch and sew?

Eat it baked or eat it fried,

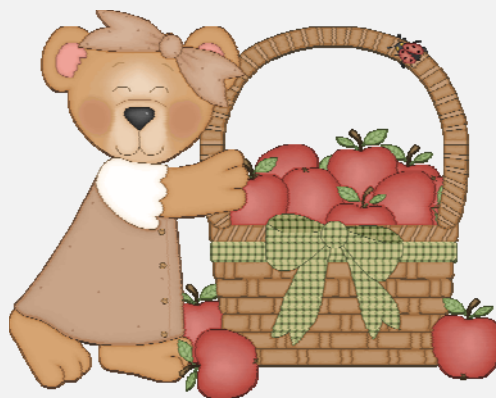
Or try some chips that have been dried.

We will go, my brother and me,

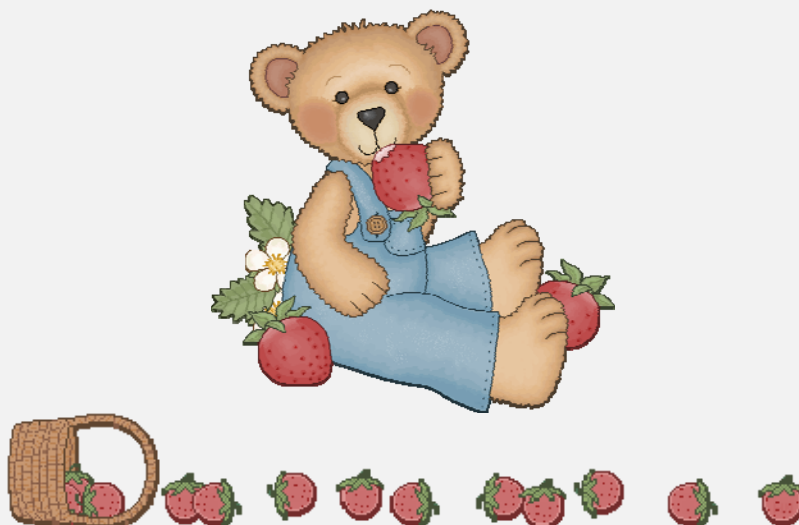
Without a fuss!
